PROMPTS FOR DEEPER DISCUSSION:

- 4. After those incredibly challenging days/months/years in the classroom, what keeps bringing you back to this profession?

SIMPLE LESSONS:

- 2. Our students need to see it if they're going to be it.
- 3. Pick your battles. (Rather than "battling" with Javier, we just bring the family meeting to him.)
- 4. All kids, no matter the age, deserve to have an adult in their life who will love them forever, no matter what.
